



2024 Guidelines for Benjamin and Edith Spaulding Scholarship Application

- 1. Scholarship Amount: \$2,500 paid in two (2) equal distributions of \$1,250. The 1<sup>st</sup> distribution shall be on August 3, 2024 and the 2<sup>nd</sup> distribution on August 2025.
- 2. Application must be postmarked by June 1, 2024.
- 3. Scholarship shall be awarded at the Family Reunion scheduled for August 1 August 4, 2024. The number of scholarship awards are based on availability of BESDA scholarship funds.
- 4. Scholarship applicant requirements (all items must be present in order for an application to be considered complete and suitable for review by the Scholarship Committee):
  - Academic Performance (High School Senior or Adult Student)
  - Must be a Descendant of the Benjamin and Edith Spaulding Family.
  - Must be accepted or enrolled in an Accredited College, University, or Community College
  - Specify Involvement in extracurricular activities / Community Service
  - One (1) Letter of Recommendation by school counselor, teacher/professor, or principal
  - Three (3) Required Essays
- 5. Scholarship will be awarded to applicants upon proof of acceptance and enrollment at the College, University, or Community College.
- 6. **High School Applicants** A transcript from the high school and enrollment certification from your College/University must be submitted with the application.
- 7. **College Applicants**-A transcript and enrollment certification from the applicant's College/University must be submitted with the application.
- 8. Please submit application between April 1, 2024- June 1, 2024, you will be notified by June 30, 2024 if you are a Scholarship Recipient.
- 9. Scholarship Recipients must abide by the following in order to receive the 2<sup>nd</sup> Scholarship disbursement:
  - Volunteer twenty (20) hours in order to receive the 2<sup>nd</sup> distribution. You may volunteer on any BESDA (Benjamin & Edith Spaulding Descendants Association) Committee. The volunteerism requirement has been enacted to encourage involvement in BESDA affairs.
  - Academic Transcript (it may be an informal academic transcript) for the 2024-2025 school year
  - Proof of enrollment for the 2025-2026 school year.
- 10. The application and all supporting documents **must** be submitted/mailed in one packet to the address on page 4.





All three (3) questions must be completed for the Scholarship.

- 1) Why do you think it is important to continue the Spaulding Reunion Tradition?
- 2) Trace your genealogy back to Benjamin and Edith Spaulding. (I am the son/daughter of...)
- 3) How will the scholarship enable you to contribute to the family heritage?

- 2. Copy of transcript/enrollment certification papers (once every semester), grades each semester and volunteer 20 hours to receive the 2<sup>nd</sup> disbursement.


